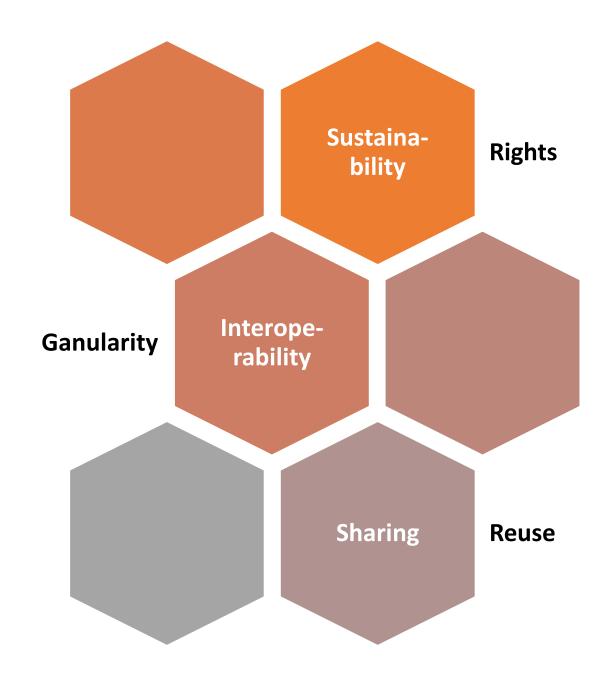




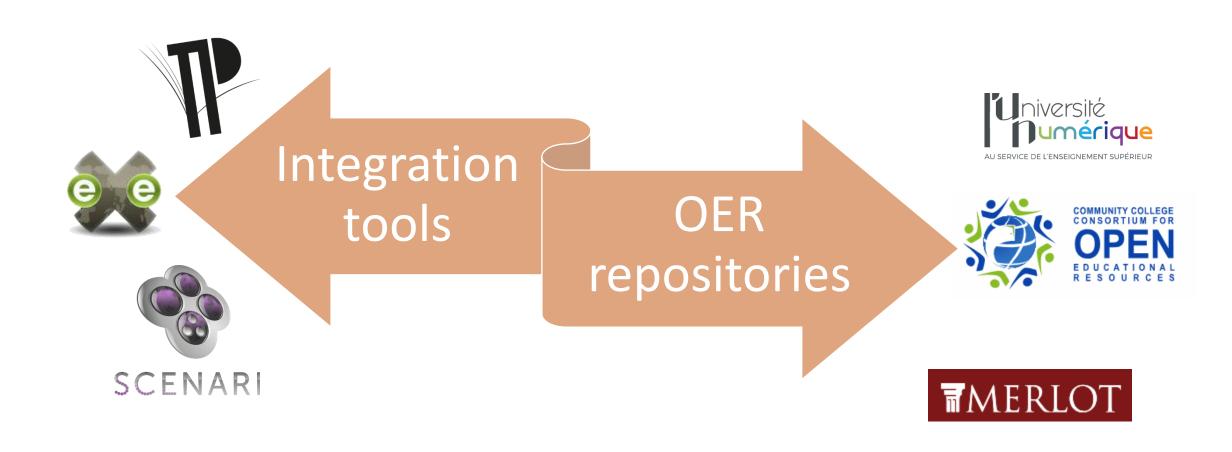

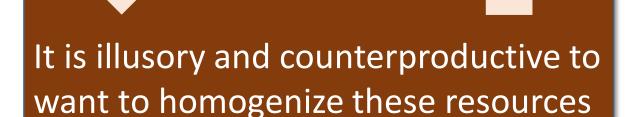


Double way for reuse (Petit, 2009)

OER are in very different forms and levels of discourse

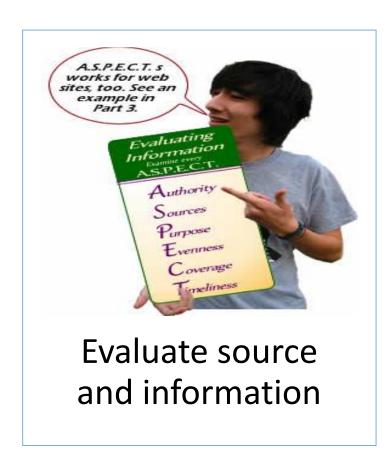


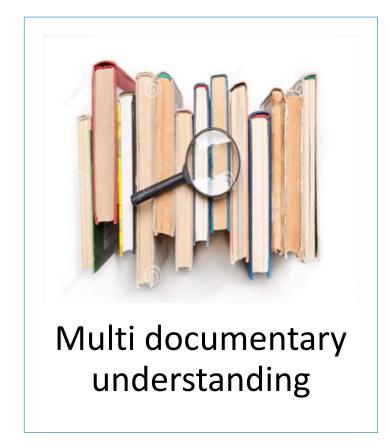


Developing OER literacy

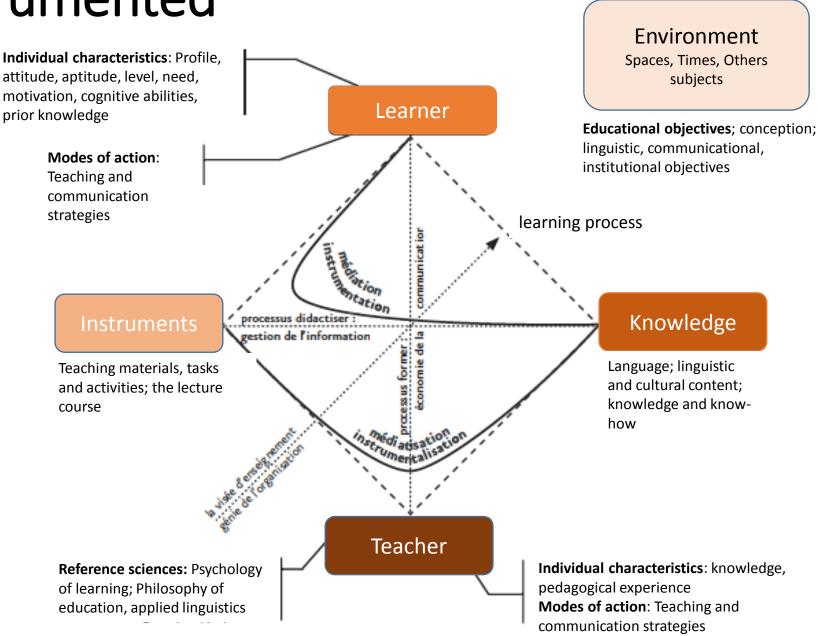


Teaching as instrumented activity Individual characteristics: Profile, attitude, aptitude, level, need,

The dual role of the teacher (Rabardel, 1995; Rezeau, 2002)

- Mediatization (content formatting)
- Mediation (use of instruments)

Requires skills or patterns and support (proximal development zone)



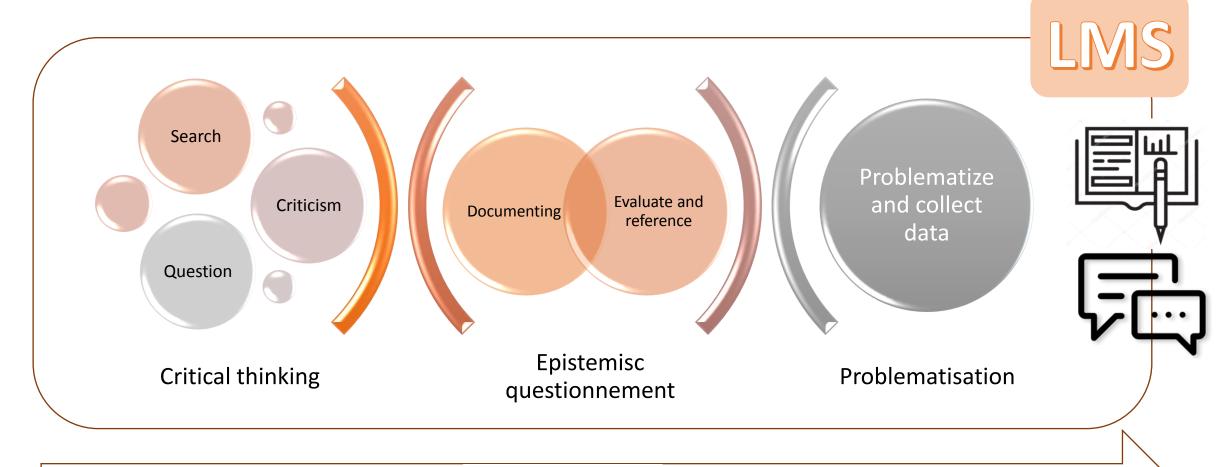
